



Conducting the audit

The purpose of this audit is for the staff member to demonstrate knowledge of skin tear dressing whilst working within organisational guidelines, policies and procedures.

The audit should be conducted by an Assessor who is familiar with wound care/skin tears. The audit combines information that is gained from theoretical and practical training. Resources in addition to the corresponding ACC program may be required to demonstrate this knowledge.

Skills Audit

This section should be completed by the Assessor by asking the staff member to describe or demonstrate the points listed in the table. The staff member should be able to describe or demonstrate each point sufficiently so that the Assessor is confident that the staff member has adequate knowledge relating to skin tear assessment and treatment.
