Restrictive Practices and Restraints

Restrictive practices refer to activities or interventions, either physical or pharmacological, that have the effect of restricting a person's free movement or ability to make decisions. There are laws around the use of any restraint in aged care. Restraint usage should always be a last resort and follow all policies and procedures, including consent, observation, documentation, and reassessment.

Consider the following alternatives:

Activities and programs	 Resident-focused activities Active listening Encourage visitors to spend time with residents Provide regular exercise programs and meaningful activities
Environment	 Set up quiet zones Welcoming areas Ensure that there are clear pathways, to promote walking outdoors
Falls prevention programs	Correct footwearProper lightingRegular toileting
Good governance	 Promote a restraint-free culture Conduct regular team meetings
Positive support strategies	 Person-centred approach Recognise each resident as an individual with their own needs and preferences Comprehensive assessment of the person, including medication Eliminate delirium and/or depression
